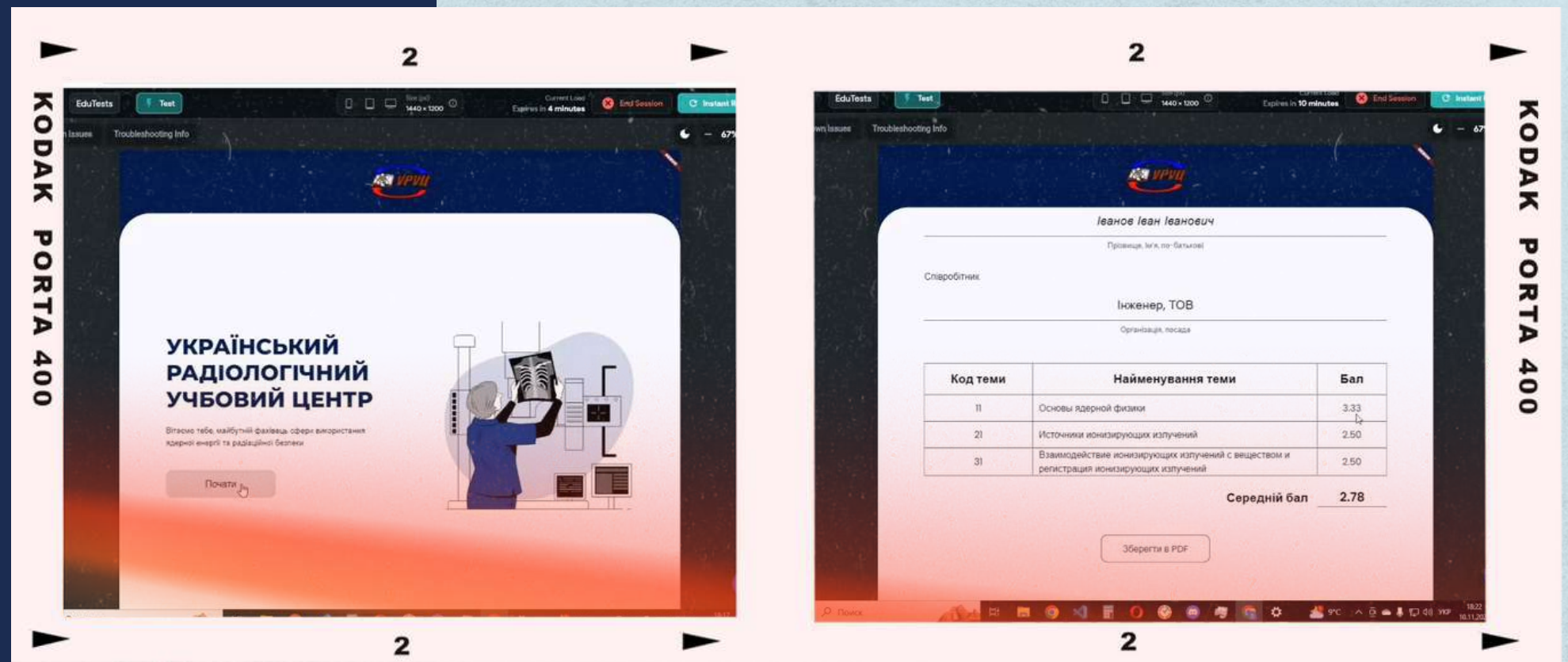

We are delighted to share the incredible progress achieved in the collaborative project between Women in Nuclear Ukraine (WiN Ukraine) and the State Agency of Ukraine on Exclusion Zone Management (SAUEZM), financed by the Swedish Radiation Safety Authority (SSM).



Over the last 25 years, the URTC has been instrumental in the professional development and certification of specialists–licensees working with ionizing radiation sources (IRS).

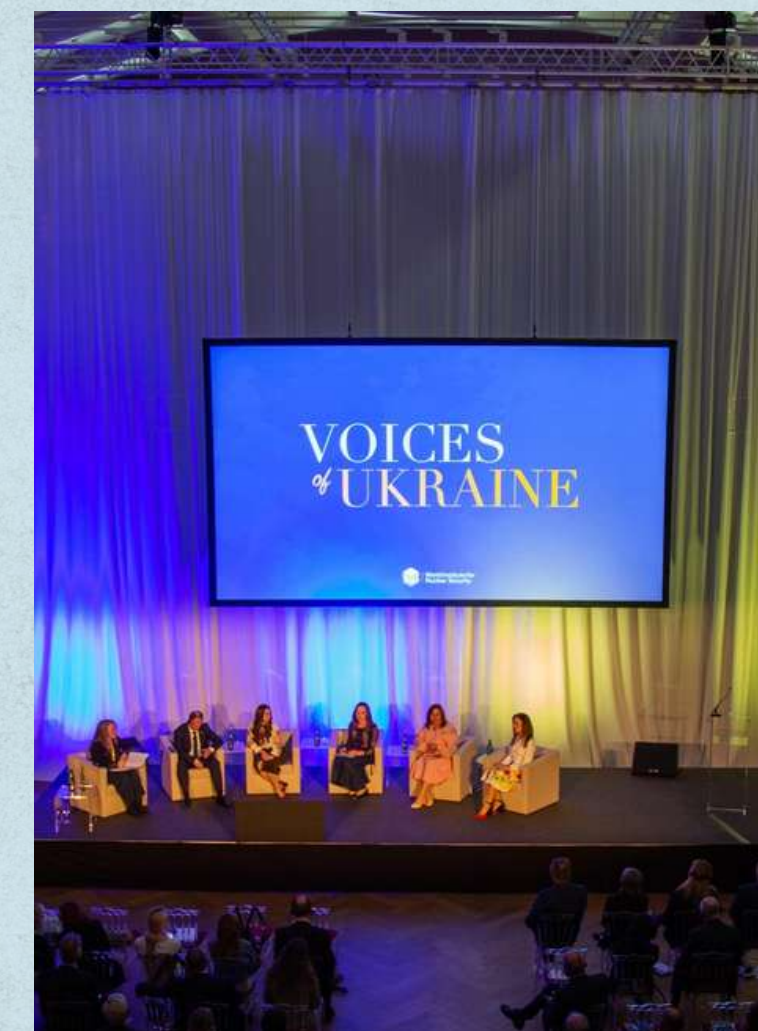
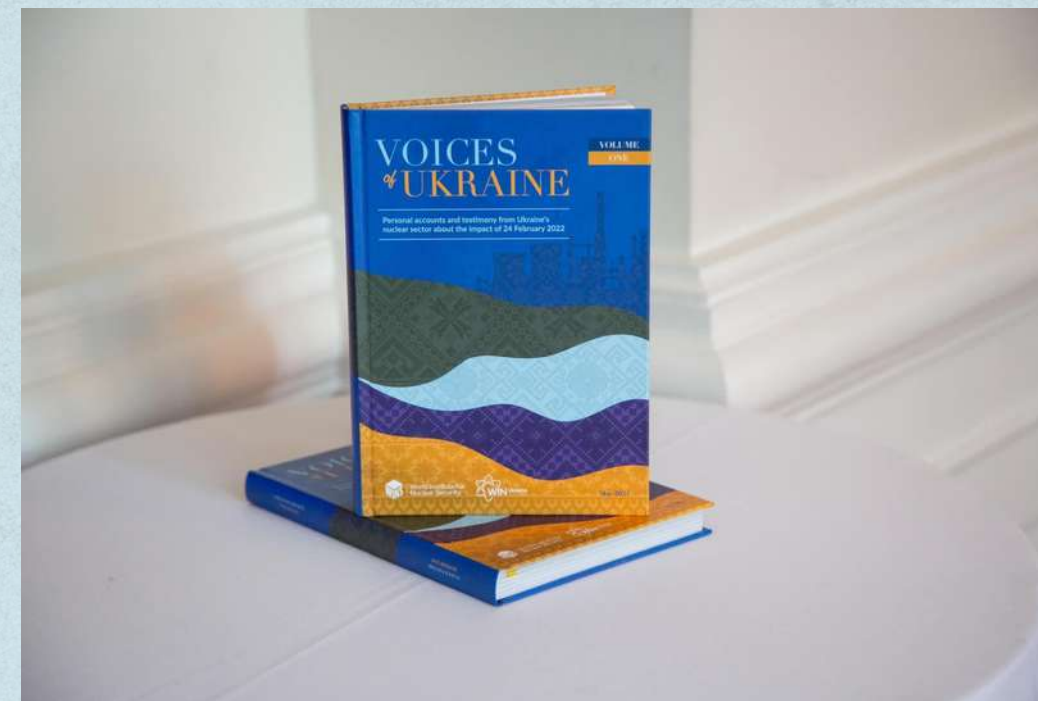
